

## ~ Welcome to Our Office ~

We want you to know that Dr. Chapman takes the responsibility of being your oral health care provider seriously, and is committed to providing you with the highest standards of care.

As a new patient, a current Full Mouth Series of radiographs (FMX) is needed for visualization of all teeth and supporting anatomy during your Comprehensive Examination.

Sometimes insurance plans cover Full Mouth Series when people transfer to a new dental office, and sometimes they do not. If they do not for any reason, the responsibility for the fee will be yours. This is between \$90-140 depending on your plan, if you have a plan.

If you had an FMX done in another office and:

- it does not arrive to our office in time,
- it arrives, but is outdated (more than 12 months, or after major work/changes have been done), or
- it does not show anatomy that is needed,

then we will need a new FMX and can do this at your initial visit. Dr. Chapman can explain any additional clinical necessity to you for the radiographs, if you desire. Please feel free to ask.
